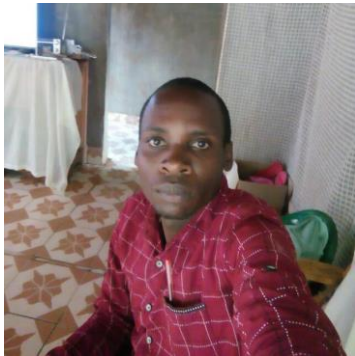

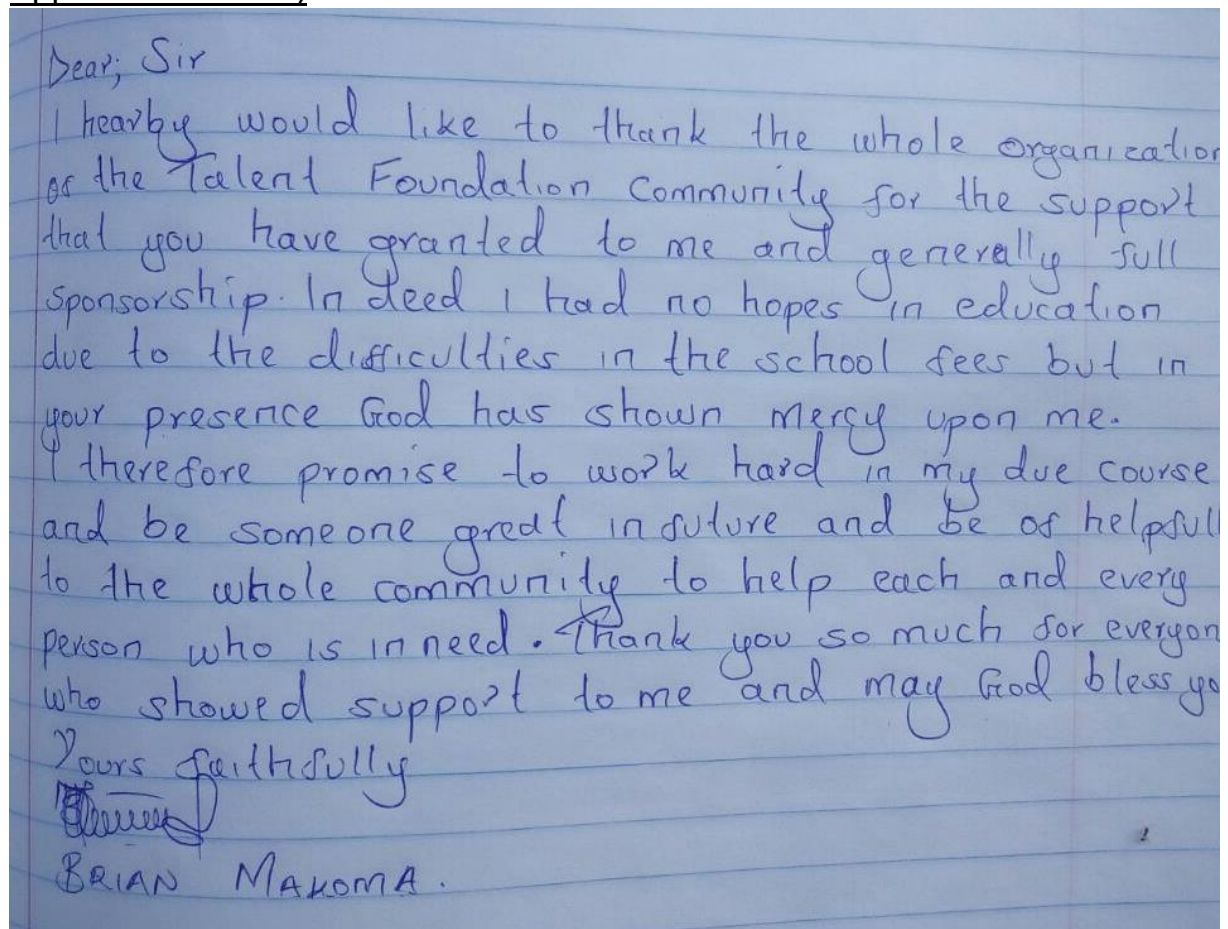
Message from Brian

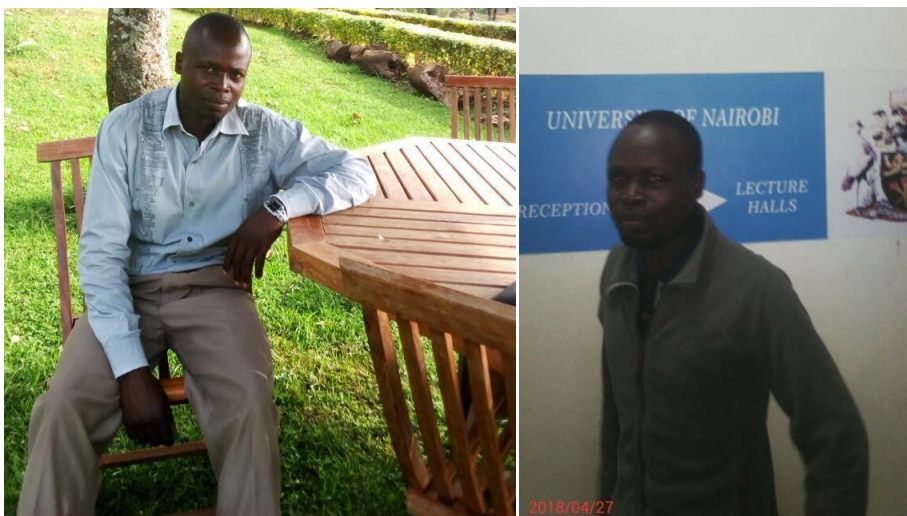

Shadrack K. Mitey : Universitaire Opleiding Community Development, Masai Mara University,Narok



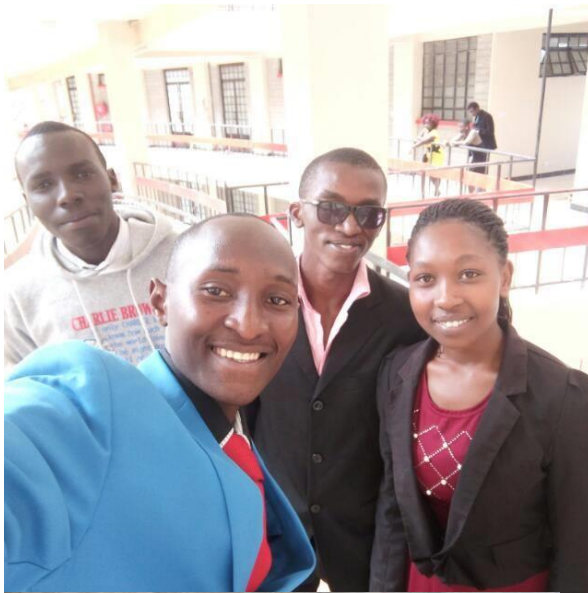

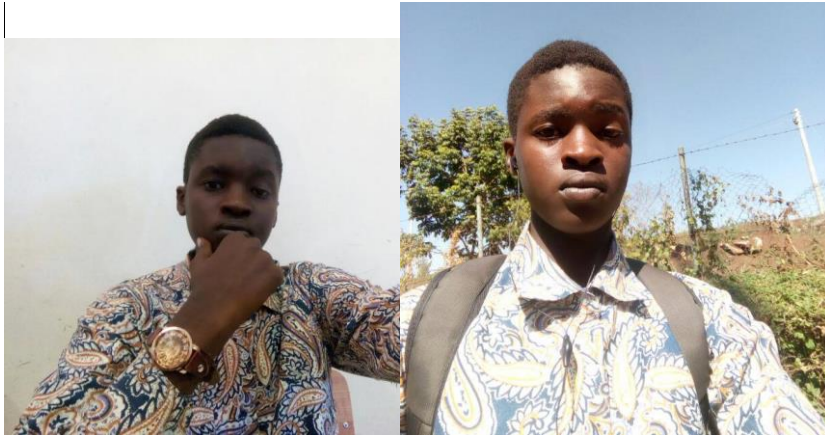

5. Integrated environment

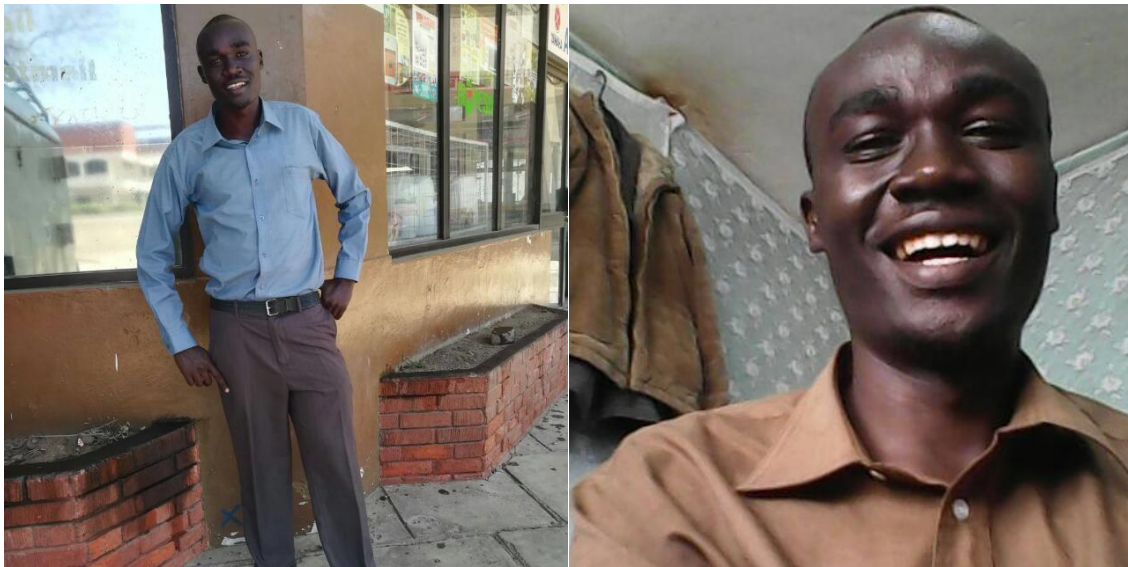

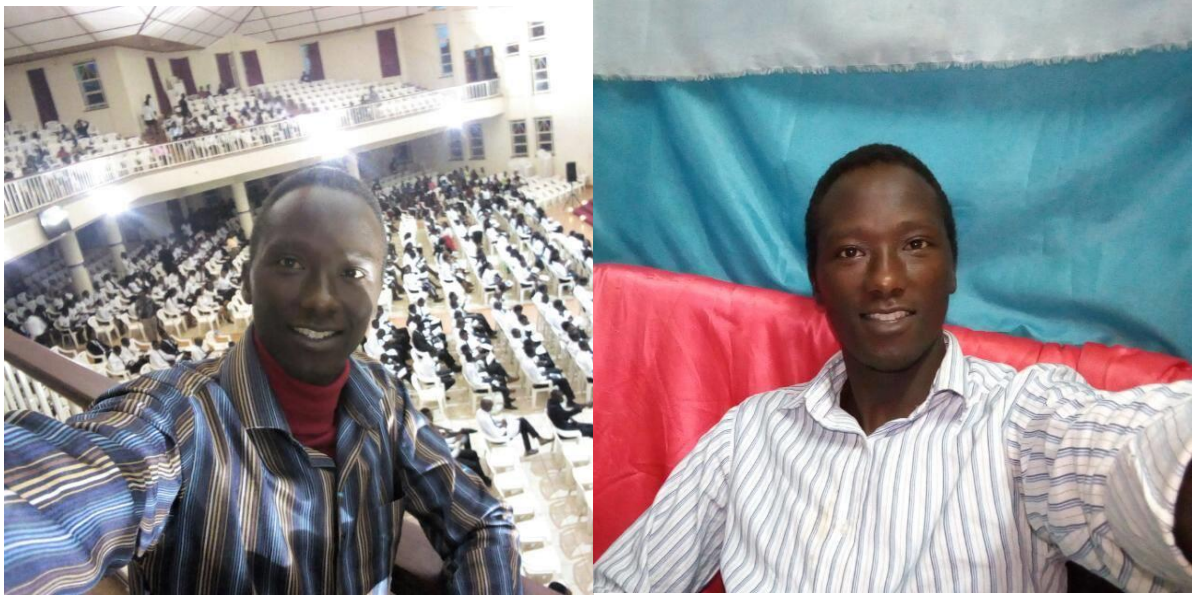
